ORDER

The above matter came on before the undersigned on March 23, 2016:

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2015, the Court entered Scheduling Order No. 2 ordering that “[i]f a plaintiff selected as a bellwether plaintiff (whether for discovery or trial) voluntarily dismisses its case, Syngenta may identify a replacement within five (5) days thereafter”;

WHEREAS, on December 22, 2015, the Court entered an Order selecting forty (40) bellwether discovery plaintiffs;

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2016, Mark D. Kallus (Non-contiguous >500) was named as a replacement bellwether discovery plaintiff to replace dismissed plaintiff Brinkman Pork Farm, Inc. (Non-contiguous >500);

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2016, bellwether discovery plaintiff Mark D. Kallus voluntarily dismissed his claims with prejudice and by Order of March 22, 2016, the Court approved the dismissals;


WHEREAS, counsel for Syngenta has notified counsel for plaintiffs of its replacement bellwether discovery plaintiff: Revell Family Farms (Non-contiguous >500), in accordance with

the process outlined in the parties' February 22, 2016 letter to the Special Master that the Court incorporated by reference in its March 1, 2016 Order regarding bellwether replacements; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby ordered that:

1. Plaintiff Revell Family Farms (Non-contiguous >500) is selected as a bellwether discovery plaintiff to replace plaintiff Mark D. Kallus (Non-contiguous >500).
